A Word from our Pastor

"I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ..." with those insightful words the Apostle Paul prayed for the Corinthian church. Paul thanked God for the grace God had given them in Christ. In the same spirit of praise I want to thank God for the grace He has bestowed on our church. He has been so kind to us over the last month. He has extended His saving grace on some of those attending services at South Burleson.
